After a few months of conversations and planning, Jaime and Cam started training the B2B-Mexico Thrive Team. The current plan is to have the Thrive Team focus on their children's homes in the state of Nuevo León, while also building out new Thrive Teams at their other sites around Mexico. They are leaders in the field of family style care and have built a process for helping get kids out of facilities and into foster families. They have a strong relationship with the state government agency over childcare (DIF Nuevo León) and are willing to help ACHF build our relationship with DIF.





RIGHT TO LIVE WITH FAMILY

The directors, Eva and Freddy, have created a loving environment for the children to feel part of a big family. They motivate sibling groups to play, eat and share time together, and try to foster unity and permanence among them. In this home, you can feel a loving family atmosphere!

RIGHT TO A STABLE ENVIRONMENT

Mama Eva talks with the children to discuss important issues, improve coexistence, give them love and set the best example. They have a system of rules based on positive discipline that allows the children to take responsibility for the consequences of their actions and to remedy their bad actions.

RIGHT TO HEALTHCARE

All children receive medical check-ups and examinations, dental and vision screenings, as well as the fitting of prescription eyeglasses. All children are given the opportunity to receive medical attention and receive treatment in case of emergency.

Realty Path is a company based in Sandy that works with 1200 real estate agents all over Utah. They invited us to their annual awards ceremony in February as one of their chosen non-profit organizations. Every time a Realty Path agent sells a home, they can choose to donate a percentage of the sale to three local non-profits chosen by Realty Path. The Realty Path brokerage matches all of those donations. This is the second year that Realty Path has made a donation to A Child's Hope Foundation (ACHF). Our Partners Global Program Partner Spotlight

I visited the One Heart Bulgaria team in Bulgaria last May with our Programs Director, Jaime. We were blown away with the work they do and what we can do together as partners in healing. Our collaborative work includes:

- Administering the Thrive Certification Program with five children's homes in Bulgaria (called Family Type Care Centers) so they can steadily improve the quality of leadership and care in the home.
- Sponsoring the One Heart Bulgaria's mentorship program so kids in Family Type Care Centers can receive personal attention from Babas (grandmas). These women provide stable, loving care. Their service helps the orphans feel love and belonging. They also provide tutoring and mentoring, just like your favorite grandma would.
- Supporting One Heart Bulgaria therapists as they are working to effectively increase the psychological healing opportunities to kids in homes.
- Creating communities of practice in government and in the nonprofit space through round table conferences in Bulgaria. One Heart Bulgaria's partnership with us goes beyond the borders of Bulgaria. Founding board member and Trustee, Kelly King, attended A Child's Hope GIVE HOPE gala last fall, her daughter Emma was a service volunteer at Ranchos de los Ninos last year.





Greg & Jane Cloward are part of <u>A Child's Hope Aunts & Uncles (monthly donors) Program</u>, and they also support Baba's (house mothers) through One Heart Bulgaria. Four years ago, Greg & Jane served a service mission to Bulgaria. They still hold a special place in their hearts for the children in Bulgaria who are in the process of healing and building new lives. Back home in Provo, Utah, Jane sews leg braces, hospital gowns and baby blankets for kids and young women that One Heart Bulgaria supports.
