Featured Story

ACHF Co-Hosted the Hope Training Conference in Baja California

With determination, flexibility, and collaboration, A Child's Hope co-hosted the Capacitación Esperanza in Tijuana with DIF Estatal de Baja California (the state agency that oversees the care of orphans and vulnerable children). This collective effort brought timely, current training to 121 people in the sector. Of those 121 participants, 42 of them were orphanage directors, 38 were psychologists, and 41 were other members of leadership at children's homes or in the state agency.

During the conference, we talked about trauma-informed care to provide real tactical support to help adults understand what best practices are for caring for a child with trauma. A notable outcome is the increased interest from government agencies in what A Child's Hope is accomplishing. We've built up a rapport and trust with them as they are now looking towards us to be a voice in the orphan care sector that can help guide some of their initiatives. Another highlight was the impact of the conference on the employees at children's homes; one of the directors said that the conference felt like a rest for her and that she'll be returning to work more motivated and confident. And that is a huge success.

As A Child's Hope explores more opportunities to support individuals and agencies in the orphan care sector, the Hope Conference serves as a great first experiment for us. We look forward to future iterations of this in Mexico and beyond!

Two of the vehicles at Casa Hogar Sion need to have their tires changed urgently, as they are frequently flat and put the children at risk of accidents. Because of the heavy rains in November in Tijuana, the roof of their pantry and supply closet collapsed at Casa Hogar Sion. They had to empty and discard a lot of the material that was damaged from the rain,. They also needed to replace this material in addition to raising money to replace the roof. Thanks to one of our amazing donors, \$1,000 was raised to support Casa Hogar Sion, allowing them to fix and replace the damaged items.

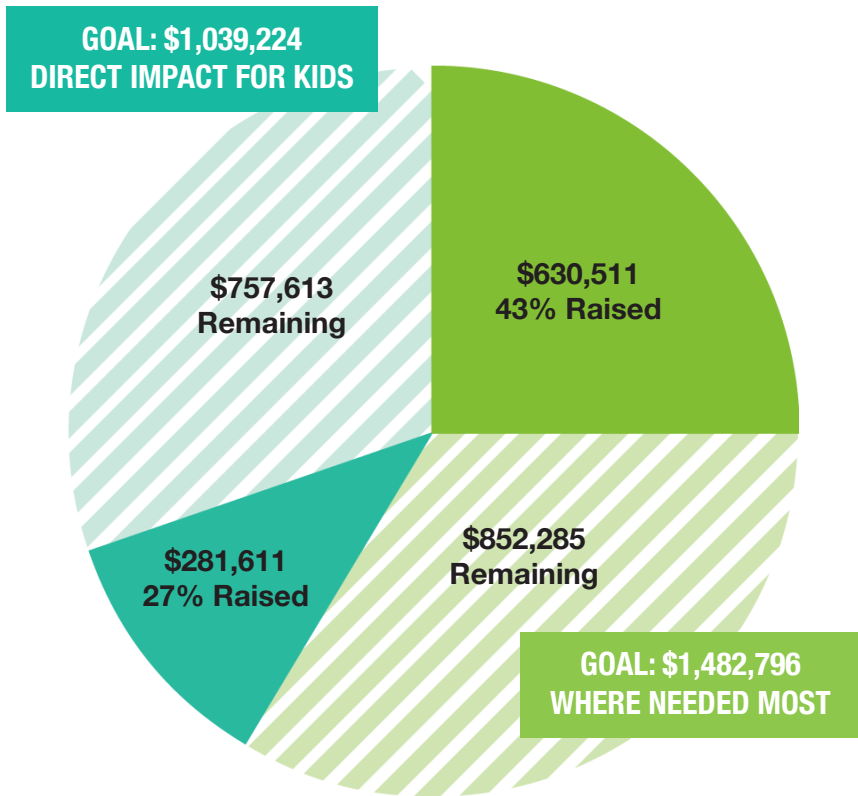

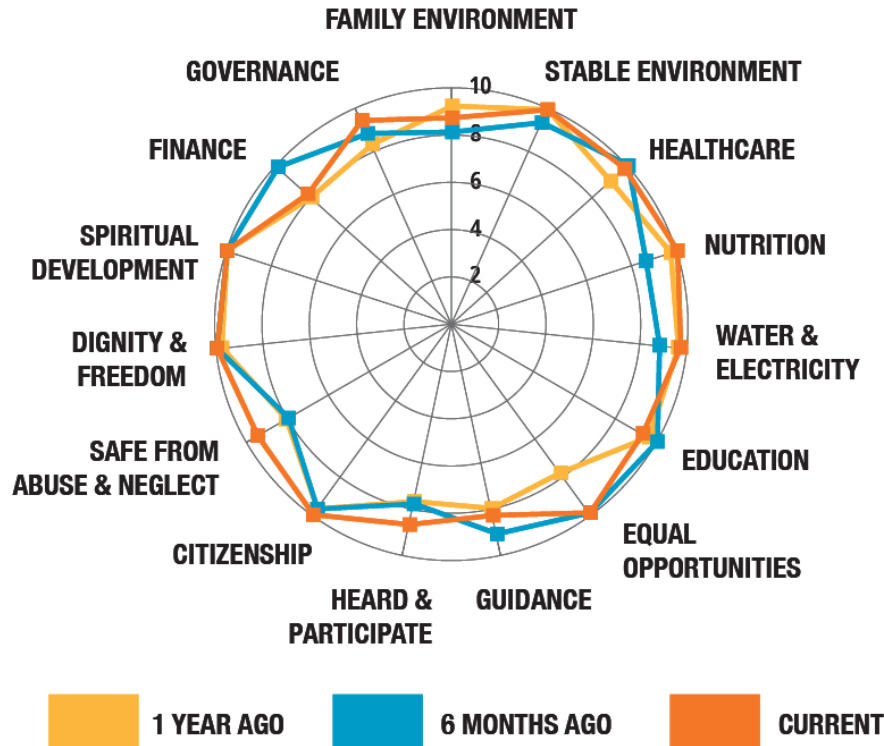

RIGHT TO NUTRITION

- In this home, they have ensured that the children are well nourished, receiving the right amount of protein, vegetables, and fruit daily. They have two nutritionists conducting nutritional assessments for each child to establish general and personalized menu plans.

RIGHT TO BE PREPARED FOR CITIZENSHIP

- All school-age children are taught courses on ethics and the democratic process; they are taught to repair the damages committed, adolescents over 15 years of age are oriented to obtain life skills to help them live independently, and they are encouraged to participate in service activities inside and outside the home.

RIGHT TO DIGNITY AND FREEDOM

- The children have had various workshops and psychological support that has helped them to strengthen good behaviors and improve their quality of life. Currently, each child has his or her bed, towel, toothbrush, sufficient clothing, underwear, and a variety of age-appropriate toys and art materials, which are available at all times.

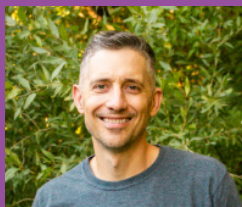
