Team Visit to Bulgaria

In early May, a group of A Child's Hope staff and volunteers had the opportunity to travel across the world for a week-long staff trip in Bulgaria. Our partner, One Heart Bulgaria, is currently working with over 20 homes and our team was able to visit 7 of those homes. The team was humbled to meet a number of directors and caregivers who lovingly support and care for the children.

A highlight of the trip was enjoying a piano recital from the children at the Mother Teresa home. Back in December, the home used their discretionary grant from the Thrive Program to purchase a digital piano. Many of their children had interest in playing and were taking lessons from a local teacher. With a piano at home, the children were able to practice often and were thrilled, despite being shy, to perform for our group during the visit. Their faces lit up with huge grins as we clapped after each song.

Overall, our staff and volunteers were deeply impacted by the different needs orphaned & vulnerable children have in Bulgaria, compared to other regions A Child's Hope supports. The team enjoyed learning more about Bulgarian culture, exploring beautiful landscapes, meeting incredible leaders and caregivers, and serving alongside One Heart Bulgaria. We are so grateful to One Heart Bulgaria for the amazing support network they have built and their willingness to implement the Thrive Program. We are excited to see the program progress to create an even greater impact for directors, caregivers, and vulnerable children within Bulgaria.

Not having an alternative source of energy, such as a power generator, has resulted in losses in the past such as food and even the loss of their pet fish due to the lack of power in the water pump.

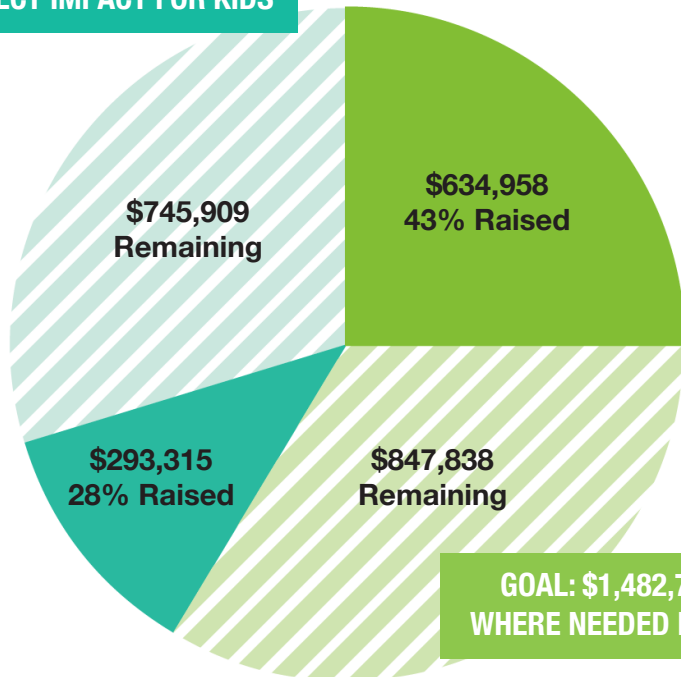

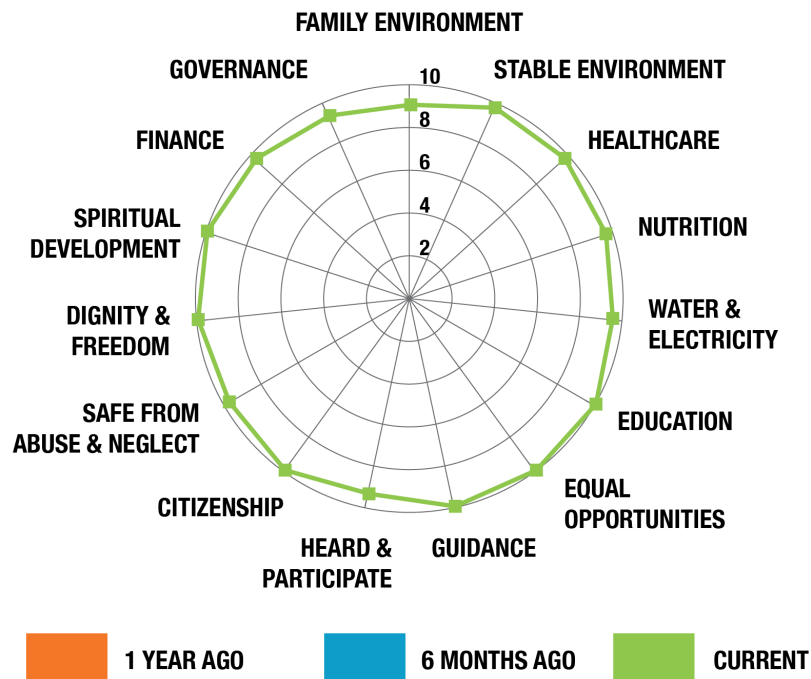

RIGHT TO EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

- All children are given the opportunity to develop their education and attend workshops related to their interests. Each child has their own bed and storage space for personal belongings. In addition, they have a life plan and a transition plan for when they have completed their time at the home.

RIGHT TO GUIDANCE

- The children are taught to be respectful, fostering in them a high level of awareness of how to treat others. All children receive psychological care. Adolescents over the age of 15 receive aptitude tests and professional counseling to determine their academic abilities.

RIGHT TO CITIZENSHIP

- Each child has a birth certificate that legally certifies their identity. The children have workshops from a lawyer on ethics and the democratic process. Adolescents over the age of 15 have mentors who teach them life skills.

A Symposium for Orphan Care in Bulgaria

In mid-May, A Child's Hope Foundation and One Heart Bulgaria co-hosted the Unity Creates Strength Orphan Care Symposium. There were 24 attendees from various organizations and children's homes who participated in the collaborative discussion. The two main aims were to 1) generate momentum for collective action and 2) increase our understanding of Bulgarian nonprofit/orphanage landscape. By all intents and purposes, we achieved our aims, and we will integrate our findings into our strategies moving forward.



What we learned: it will take more time, more relationships, and more conversations to create the groundswell for change we hope to see in the Bulgarian orphan care sector, but we started moving it in the right direction. We know that we can only make the change if we do it together; and we are happy to have One Heart Bulgaria by our side.
