DIF Summit Success

In a combined effort with The Stirling Foundation, A Child's Hope Foundation hosted a delegation of eight amazing DIF (National System for Integral Family Development) leaders from three states in Mexico (Baja California, Nuevo León, Jalisco). The outcomes of the week surpassed our expectations and have left us energized, collaborative, and HOPEful.

The objective of the week was three-fold:

- Facilitate and strengthen connections between DIF leaders, A Child's Hope, and our partners
- Understand the context of the work each DIF state is doing
- Generate next steps for each partner to take with DIF in the three states

On one of the days, we introduced all of the delegates to four of our Partners (Back2Back Ministries, The Hope Effect, Both Ends Believing, and Saprea) to hear what programs they provide. The presentations and one-on-one conversations that followed buzzed with excitement and expectation. Clear opportunities were discussed and planned between the states and the respective Partners.

Gaby I., a representative from DIF Jalisco, said: “[The partnership with A Child's Hope is] very valuable, because thanks to you we managed to have this approach [to improving and expanding their services]; otherwise we would not have had it, perhaps it would never have

occurred to us to look for this support in the United States... Now we see that this is not the case; we have many things in common; and above all, we share a love for children, particularly for [vulnerable] children, and we seek the same goal, which is that one day we can say that we don't need more orphanages. I am truly amazed at [A Child's Hope's] work and I admire and appreciate their commitment to children.”

We are so grateful for everyone who contributed to making this summit a huge success. We look forward to more collaboration in the future!

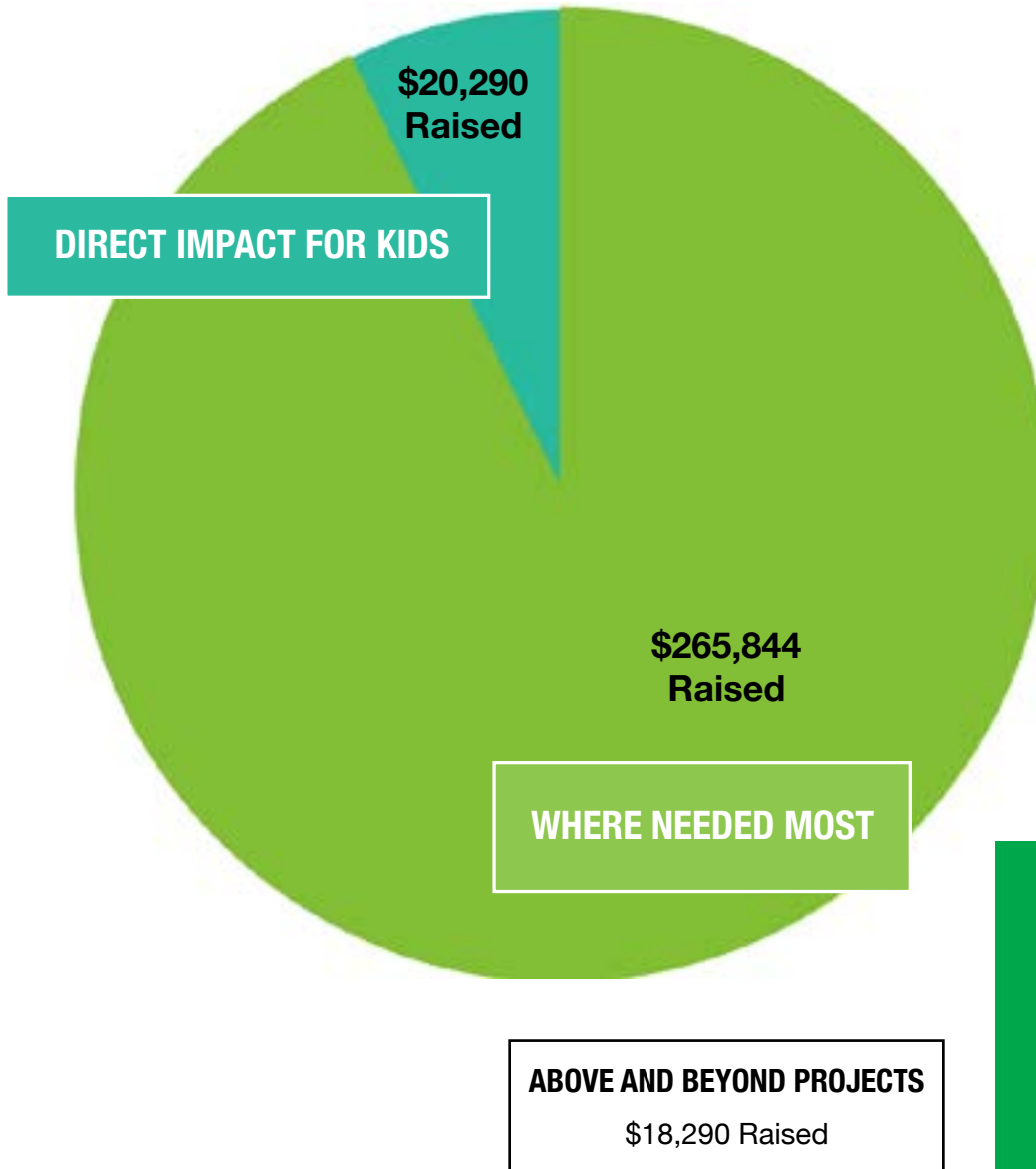

RIGHT TO A STABLE, LOVING & NURTURING ENVIRONMENT

- Caregivers in this home rely on positive discipline to guide the children when correction is needed. Rancho la Hermosa's collaborators meet with the psychologist to discuss situations to improve their work in caring for the children.

RIGHT TO DIGNITY AND FREEDOM

- The children have access to their own beds and are provided with sufficient underwear, towels and clean sheets. The directors and caretakers encourage the children to respect each other and to live together in a loving and harmonious way.

RIGHT TO SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

- The children belong to a religious community and are very attached to it. They participate in the activities of their community, and the girls are involved in a dance group at the church. The home has religious materials such as books, bibles and music that are easily accessible to the children.

Partner Training Grants In Action



One of the ways A Child's Hope Foundation supports our partners is through Partner Training Grants. These grants are accessible to our Deployment Partners who are seeking resources to help them expand their programs, receive training, and/or deliver trainings.

Recently, Oak Life (our Deployment Partner in Chapala, Jalisco, Mexico) hosted a Director's Conference for directors of children's shelters. Directors from four local shelters were present. The event was held in Spanish, marking Oak Life's first Spanish-exclusive and director-exclusive conference. Session topics included Evidence-Based Administration, Creating a Positive Environment for Staff, Sexual Abuse Prevention, and Family-Building Practices.

We are proud of the work Oak Life is doing to connect, equip, and empower the leaders of children's homes in their region and beyond. They are filling a need for professionalization of workers in the orphan and vulnerable children care space, and we are seeing the impact!
