Purpose of Child Advancement Programs (CAP) Action Teams

The CAP Action Teams are intended to bring together some of the most talented and invested minds in a particular subject in an effort to support the therapeutic, educational and mentoring programs that are currently aiming to support over 500 kids globally. The work of each Action Team helps ACHF 1) stay updated on current research and best practices in the field, 2) design and implement aligned program efforts, and 3) inspire donors to commit to our work.

Profile of an Action Team Member

Each CAP Action Team is composed of 2-5 team members who are highly invested in one of the target areas and are personally interested in helping A Child's Hope launch related initiatives. We know that diverse teams can facilitate greater impact, so we are looking for team members who can check any/all of these qualifications:

- Has past/present professional experience in the target area,
- Has formal education in the target area
- Has connections to related and relevant:
 - Individuals/networks (for funding, program development, etc.)
 - Policy makers
 - Universities

The Role of a CAP Action Team Member

1. **Research and maintain up-to-date thematic awareness of the target area**, including best practices, emerging research, the work of other actors in the same domain, potential partners, implementation and evaluation methods.
2. **Contribute to the development, implementation, and evaluation of CAP initiatives**, through active participation, brainstorming, volunteering to own smaller milestone projects that align with your expertise/experience/passions, etc.
3. **Help ensure programmatic alignment.** Understand the Certification and Child Advancement Programs and be able to accurately represent those programs to both in-country persons as well as external partners and interested parties.
4. **Support the ACHF Fundraising team in securing the funds needed for CAP operations**, including close coordination, referrals, and introductions.

Expectations of a CAP Action Team Member

- Active Involvement | CAP Action Team members should plan to spend 2-5 hours a month, including a monthly meeting at most.
- Commitment | Each CAP Action Team has between 2 and 5 members who serve 2 year terms with the ability to reapply.
