Purpose of Regional Action Teams

The six Regional Action Teams are intended to bring together some of the most talented and invested minds for a particular geographic region. The work of each Action Team helps ACHF 1) stay updated on current events, 2) understand and support programmatic alignment, and 3) inspire donors to commit to our work.

Profile of a Regional Action Team Member

Each Regional Action Team is composed of 2-5 team members who are highly invested in one of the regions and are personally interested in helping A Child's Hope plan, launch, and fund initiatives. We know that diverse teams can facilitate greater impact, so we are looking for team members who can check any/all of these qualifications (the list is *not* exhaustive):

- Has connections to
 - government agents/agencies in the region
 - universities in the region or working in the region
 - relevant networks (businesses, nonprofits, orphanages, etc)
- Has past/present service experience in the region
- Has heritage or family ties to the region
- Has a strong commitment to the region

The Role of a Regional Action Team Member

1. **Research and maintain up-to-date situational awareness of the region**, including policy surrounding orphan care, government, partnerships, safety, etc. Leverage connections to ensure the cultural appropriateness and effectiveness of ACHF programs.
2. **Help ensure programmatic alignment.** Understand the Certification and Child Advancement Programs and be able to accurately represent those programs to both in-country persons as well as external partners and interested parties.
3. **Support the ACHF Fundraising team in securing the funds needed for regional operation**, including close coordination, referrals, and introductions.

Expectations of a Regional Action Team Member

- **Active Involvement** | Regional Action Team members should plan to spend 2-5 hours a month, including a monthly meeting at most.
- **Commitment** | Each Regional Action Team has between 2 and 5 members who serve 2 year terms with the ability to reapply.
